

WHAT IS VIDEO CALLING

- Video calling is like a phone call but with video too
- Uses the internet
- On some services pictures, videos clips and files can be shared during the call
- Not all participants of the call need to have video switched on

- Facebook Messenger
- WhatsApp
- Facetime on Apple devices
- Google Duo on Android devices











HOW TO MAKE A VIDEO CALL

- Press the video camera button on the person you are trying to contact to dial them. Your video will appear in the corner while it dials
- If they accept the call then their video will pop up





PROS & CONS



- Allows you to see and hear people during a call
- Free through a variety of services, choose which is best for you



- Requires an internet connection
- Requires a webcam.
 Most laptops, tablets
 and smart phones
 already have webcams
